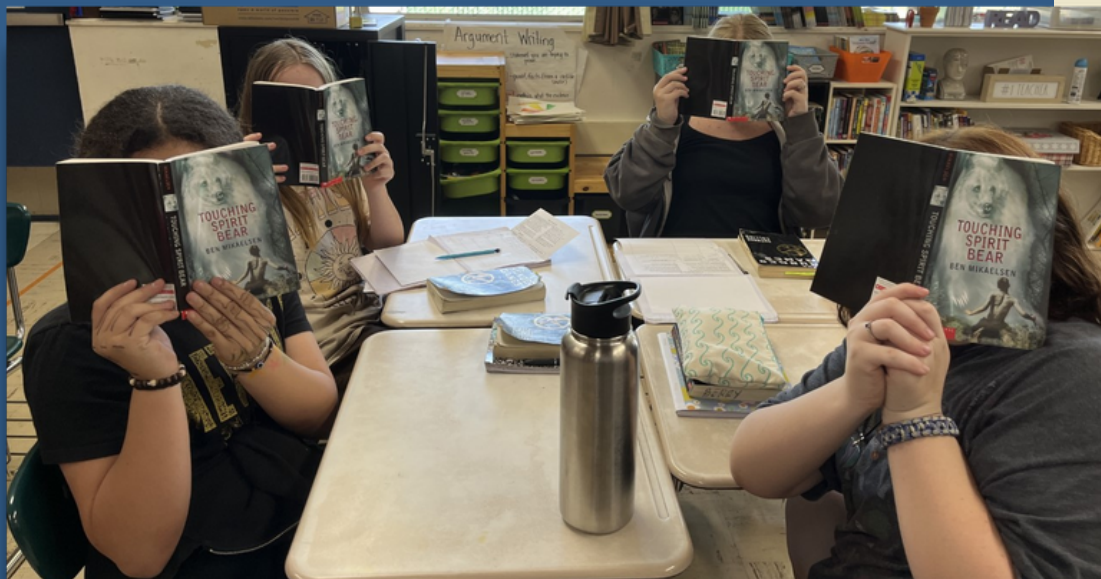

We also added two new funds to our scholarship portfolio and that portfolio of nine scholarship funds supported 36 students with their post-high school education plans.

We also struck up a terrific partnership with Capital Road Race Management becoming the beneficiary of the Fair Oaks Sun Run. With the support of one hundred and seventy of our closest friends, we raised \$90,000, including \$15,000 specifically to fund Direct-to-Teacher grants, at our An Evening with the Stars Gala.

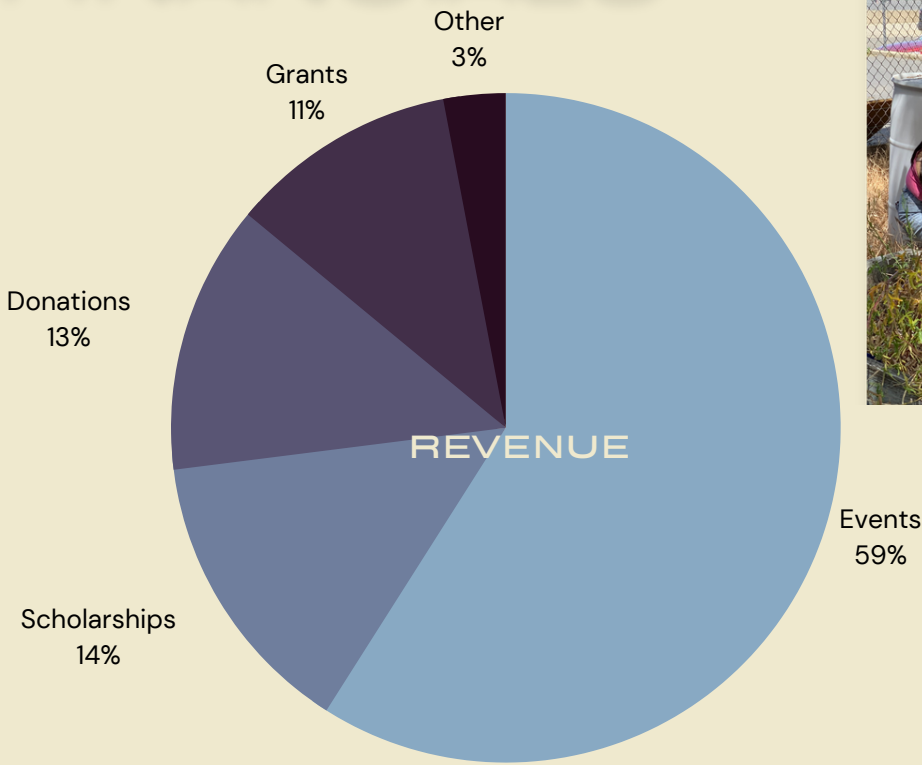

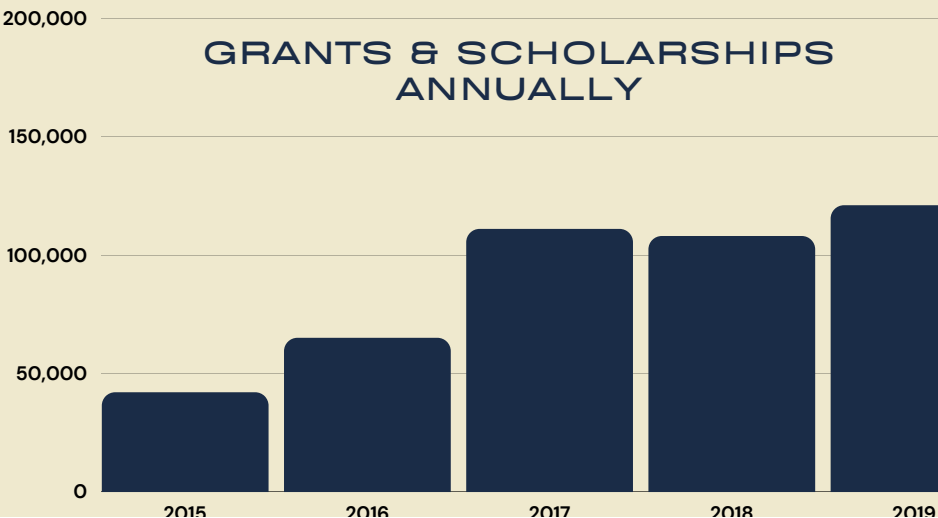
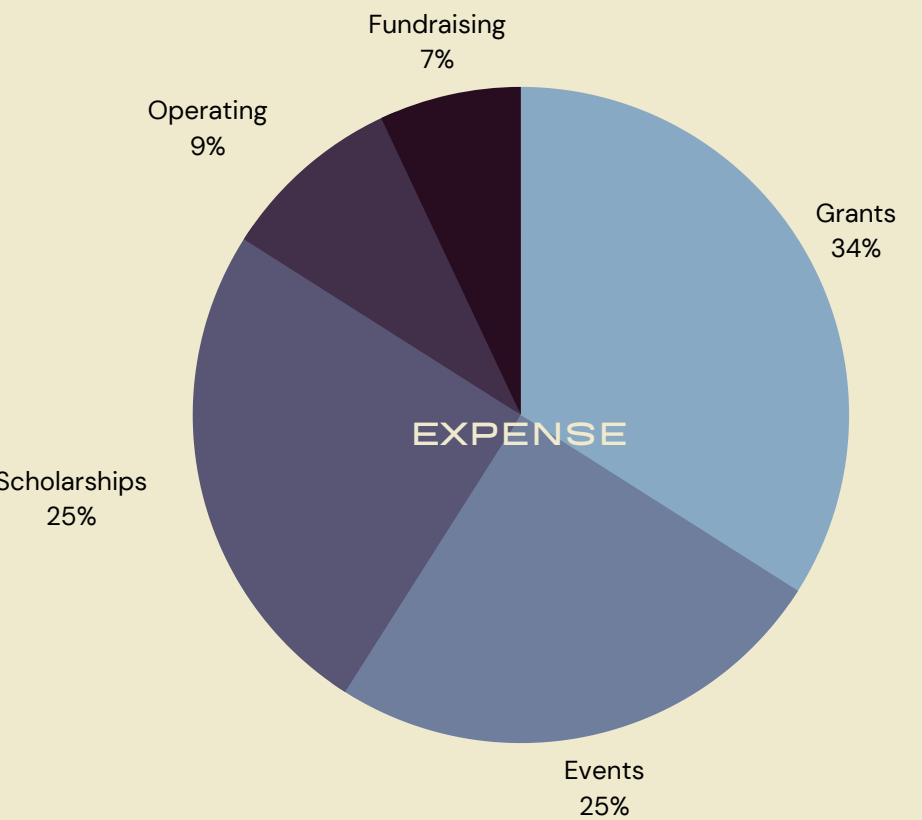
